	Item Nos. 02 to 03 May 1, 2015	M.A. NO. 408 OF 2015 No suggestions have been moved on behalf of the Applicant. In interest of environment and free flow of traffic, we direct the completion of the work for providing central verge, as decided by the Administration and on which to a large extent work has been completed. There will no place in the central verge as it would obviously

result in congestion of traffic and increased emissions resulting in pollution load and would be of great danger to the human life. Let this work be completed without any delay and proper traffic lights would be fixed for providing proper turns including U turns from the road and towards Don Bosco School. The SHO concerned is directed to provide all due assistance for execution of the work by the Administration.

Original Application No.21 of 2014 & Original Application No. 95 of 2014

The NCT of Delhi, Ministry of Petroleum, Ministry of Urban Development, MoEF even the other public Authorities including State of Uttar Pradesh and Haryana have not submitted any suggestions in terms of our Order dated 13th April, 2015. An Application has been moved on behalf of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways in which Learned Addl. Solicitor General would be submitting further suggestions.

In light of the above, we are not in a position to proceed with the matter further but we make it clear that if all these Ministries and State Governments do not comply with our order dated 13th April, 2015 we will be compelled to proceed with the matter and forfeit their rights to submit any suggestion or data. Let the needful be done within two weeks from today with advance copies to all the learned counsel appearing in the matter.

All other States should also file their suggestions within two weeks from today.
