

Minutes of the AEMC meeting held under the chairmanship of Secretary (Environment), GNCTD on 29th October 2009 in the Conference Room of Department of Environment, Delhi Secretariat, I P Estate, New Delhi -110002 to discuss ATR of balance agenda.

The list of participants of the meeting is attached as Annexure-I.

The participants were informed that the Airfield Environment Management Committee (AEMC) meeting held on 01st October 2009 at IGI Airport, wherein some of the agenda points were not discussed due to absence of Officials from concerned Department (i.e. Sanitation Department of MCD, I&FC Department and Delhi Police (South)). The purpose of meeting is to review the ATR of balance agenda of previous AEMC meeting. At the outset, it was decided that following actions would be taken:

1. **Garbage Disposal around Dwarka Area:** Delhi Waste Management Company to clear garbage twice a day in the Dwarka Sector 8, 22, 23 & 24.

Representative of MCD informed that M/s City Lifeline Pvt. Ltd. is clearing garbage twice a day in the Dwarka Sector 8, 22, 23 and 24. It was decided that MCD should monitor the removal of garbage on regular basis.

(Action: **MCD**)

2. **Water Stagnation around IGI Airport**

As per DDA, water stagnation at Dwarka sector 20 and 22 is due to problem in Trunk Drain No 2. Construction of outfall has to be carried out by I&F C Deptt for which payment has been made by DDA. Representative from I & FC Department informed that drain connected to the outfall has to be constructed by DDA and only portion of outfall has to be constructed by I & FC Department. Construction of outfall will be started by 15th November 2009 and it will take 1 year to complete.

(Action: **I & FC Dept. and DDA**)

3. **Delhi Police and MCD jointly must ensure that no illegal meat shops operated in Indra Market, R K Puram.**

As per DCP (South) reply, 23 cases have been registered in 2008-09 under DMC Act. Besides, joint action by MCD & local Police against illegal/unauthorized meat shops has been carried out in several area of PS. R K Puram. Chairman asked for permanent solution because 23 FIR in 365 days are insufficient to solve the issue. It was suggested that MCD should review the tehbazari in the said area to control the illegal Meat Shops. DCP and MCD should initiate action separately and jointly against the illegal meat shops operated in Indra Market, R K Puram under the Police Act and MCD Act respectively. Sanitation Department of MCD was directed to remove garbage /slaughter waste regularly from the drain/area. It was also suggested that similar public

message should also be displayed by MCD in the concerned area/drains as displayed by DDA.

(Action: **Delhi Police (South) & MCD**)

4. MCD to ensure that there is no slaughter waste dumping in the nearby drains in Indra Market, R K Puram.

EE of DEMS(MCD) assured that slaughter waste will be removed from nearby drains in Indra Market, R K Puram on priority.

(Action: **MCD**)

5. Removing of waste from Pankha Road Drain.

I&FC Officials informed that out of 5.3 Km, 3.6 Km of drain belongs to their Department, which is cleaned. However, 1.7 km stretch is belongs to MCD, which is uncleaned. In response, EE of DEMS(MCD) assured that 1.7 Km stretch will be cleaned in priority. It was also decided that a DO letter from Secretary (Environment) be sent to Commissioner, MCD.

(Action: **I & FC Deptt. & Environment Department**)

6. Garbage disposal shall be carried out every day by MCD in Sadar Bazar area.

EE of DEMS(MCD) informed that MCD is clearing garbage every day in Sadar Bazar area.

(Action: **MCD**)

7. Garbage dumping near Manglapuri Bus Terminal

EE of DEMS(MCD) assured that garbage will be removed from Manglapuri Bus Terminal area on priority.

(Action: **MCD**)

8. ATR of decision taken in the Consent Management Committee (Delhi Pollution Control Committee) meeting held on 28.01.2009 regarding Water and Wastewater Management in IGI Airport.

ATRs of all caterers have been discussed and it was decided to expedite the unfinished work. Pointwise detailed ATRs be submitted to DPCC. This issue will be again discussed in Consent Management Committee separately.

(Action: **DIAL/** Taj Sats Air Catering Ltd / Ambassador Sky Chef / Oberoi Flight Services / **M/s Sky Gourmet /M/s** Centaur Hotel)

Chairman (AEMC) –cum Secretary (Env.) desired that DIAL should send monitoring report of each action points to the MCD and Delhi Police every week.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
