Minutes of the Airfield Environment Management Committee Meeting

Venue: Conference Hall No. 3, 2nd level Delhi Secretariat
IP Estate, New Delhi-02.

Date: 20th Sep 2016
Time: 1100Hrs

A meeting of Airfield Environment Management Committee under the Chairmanship of Sh. Chandraker Bharti, IAS, Secretary (Environment), Delhi Govt. was held in Delhi Secretariat on 20th September 2016. The list of participants is placed at Appendix 'A'

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all participants and requested the DIAL representative to set the context and give the presentation on the agenda of the meeting. DIAL representative gave the detailed presentation wherein the action points were divided and discussed in following four categories:-

- A. Issues requiring immediate action and legal improvement.
- B. Issues requiring urgent one time action
- C. Issues requiring constant attention
- D. Bird management system and infrastructure improvement

Category A: Issues requiring immediate action and legal improvement:

A1) Illegal waste dumping and de-skinning of Animal at Rangpuri Pahadi

It was brought to the notice of the Committee that joint inspection of Rangpuri Pahadi area is being carried out comprising of representatives of DIAL & DDA and site visit report is being communicated to DDA, SDMC, Department of Environment and DGCA periodically. However, there is no improvement in the status of the area. The illegal dumping of the waste is still continuing without any restriction.

On enquiry from the Chairman, the DDA official intimated that ownership of said land is disputed and matter is under litigation. Therefore, the cleaning of the area is getting delayed. Chairman informed that the area being subjudice do not prohibit the cleaning of the area in the interest of public safety. Further, the permission of the Hon'ble court can also be obtained in this regard, if required. The DDA officials agreed for taking up the matter with appropriate authority for initiating the cleaning work on priority.

Regulatory authorities can also fine the agency/ person holding possession of land.

(Action: DDA / SDMC)

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A2) Illegal meat selling in Indira Market – R K Puram and regular removal of garbage and slaughter waste from drain by SDMC.

It was pointed out in the presentation that illegal meat shops are still operating and shop owners are throwing waste in adjacent drain. This is main cause of increased bird activity in the area which falls in approach path of Runway 28. Neither boundary wall nor wire mesh has been erected for preventing animal waste being dumped in drain.

Chairman directed DDA and SDMC for early removal of illegal meat shops and to increase the frequency of garbage cleaning. Chairman also advised to take support of Delhi Police for removing encroachment, if required.

The representatives of DDA and SDMC agreed to take action accordingly. The representative of Delhi Police also stated that all necessary support shall be given to Government agencies whenever requested including filing the FIR under relevant acts.

Chairman further directed that in order to effectively monitor the action taken and efficient coordination between various agencies, a local Coordination Committee comprising of senior officials of all concerned agencies may be constituted. This Committee can meet more often to address various issues instead of waiting for this meeting which normally meets once in a year.

DIAL to initiate the process for constituting the Coordination Committee as proposed by the Chairman and review the progress on the issues requiring immediate action and legal improvement (Category A items) within three months from the date of MoM.

(Action: DDA / SDMC /Delhi Police / DIAL)

A3) Garbage dump at Shahbad Mohmmadpur/ Bagdola Village

The Shahbad Mohamadpur area lies next to airport perimeter wall and any garbage accumulation increases direct threat to aircraft safety. It was pointed out that huge amount of garbage is being generated on daily basis and same is thrown in open area. There is an urgent need for large waste container or provision of underground dalaos to be made in the said area so that garbage gets collected in a confined manner. It was also pointed out that despite reminders, MCD officials of reasonable seniority are not reporting for monthly joint survey of the area which makes the process ineffective.

Chairman directed SDMC Najafgarh Zone that the provision of large garbage bins or dhalaos should be explored and the area needs to be cleaned more frequently on regular basis. Chairman also directed MCD that senior level officer of the rank of Executive Engineer should be part of inspection team along with DIAL team to inspects areas on monthly basis.

(Action: SDMC)

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Category B: Issues requiring urgent one time Action :

B1) DIAL team explained the status of relocation of Blue Bulls from airport area and asked for extension till the project completes. Due to rain and heavy vegetation the capture got delayed.

(Action: Forests Dept.)

Category C: Issues requiring constant attention:

C1) Garbage disposal around Railway track / Bharthal Village and Mahipal Pur area

It was informed in the presentation that regular waste removal and provision of covered bins are required in the above area as it falls in approach/ Take off path of aircraft. The area is also visited by DIAL along with MCD officials during its periodic surveys. However, no support from Indian Railways has been forthcoming for addressing the issue.

Chairman advised that letter should be sent to Railways from Department of Environment, Government of NCT-Delhi seeking support for cleanliness of area on both side of track that is passing close to western side of the IGI Airport between Palam and Bijwasan village. Also, the representative of Indian Railways may also be invited for this meeting in future.

(Action: Northern Indian Railways / Department of Environment, Govt. of NCT)

C2) Waste water logging / solid waste dumping and cleaning of drain near DDA flats Nasir Pur.

DIAL informed that garbage dumping near the drain is still prevalent and there is requirement of wire mesh/ fencing to deter general public dumping waste therein.

Chairman directed MCD and I&FC to strengthen the waste management and ensure waste material are not dumped in open and adopt proper waste management techniques. He further directed concerned agency to install proper fencing to avoid any further dumping in that location.

(Action: I & FC/ DDA/ SDMC)

C3) Garbage dumping in open area in Mangla Puri, Bus Terminal and illegal meat shops operating in the area.

The situation has slightly improved in the area but increase in frequency of garbage removal will further improve the situation. However meat shops are still operating which are main cause of concern and attracts lot of birds.

Chairman directed SDMC to increase the frequency of waste removal and ensure that senior level officer of the rank of executive engineer to be part of inspection team along with DIAL team that inspects areas on monthly basis. He also directed not to keep waste dumping in open area and strengthen the waste management system.

(Action: SDMC/DDA/ Delhi Police/DIAL)

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Category D: Birds Management system and infrastructural improvement:

D1) Dabri Mor Meat Shops

DIAL informed the Chairman that illegal meat shop are still operating at Dabri Mor.

The Chairman directed DDA to carry out operation to remove or close the illegal meat shops operating without permit in that area. Further, he advised that, assistance of Delhi Police may also be taken to file necessary FIR or removal of the shops, in case of requirement. These shops be used for purpose these were allotted and DDA should initiate action for change in use against the allottee.

(Action: SDMC /DDA/ Delhi Police)

D2) Cleaning of Drain in Dwarka Zone:

It was informed that cleaning of drains and removal of garbage at road side near the drain needs to be increased.

Chairman directed DDA to take necessary action in the matter to address the same.

(Action: DDA)

D3) Requirement of Signage at Sector 21 Dwarka underpass:

It was informed in the meeting about the criticality of Sector 21 Dwarka underpass area as it lies in Runway 11 approach and any bird concentration in this area increases threat to aircraft safety. In spite of removing of water pots and seed grains from adjacent area, they are again placed by general public out of ignorance to Aircraft related risk due traditional/ religious practice. Area comes under DDA jurisdiction and is requested to put signage to create awareness among public to avoid feeding birds.

Chairman directed DDA to take necessary action for putting the required signage highlighting the danger of birds to flying aircraft and to discourage general public from throwing seed grains.

(Action: DDA)

At the end, Chairman concluded by appreciating the efforts of all agencies and asked them to continue working to improve the situation and advised formation of committee for better coordination.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.








