MINUTES OF MEETING

Subject: Minutes of the meeting with respect to Airfield Environment Management Committee held on 08.01.2019 at Delhi Secretariat.

A meeting of Airfield Environment Management Committee (AEMC) was held at Delhi Secretariat on 08.01.2019 under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Environment) of Secretary (Environment), Govt. of NCT of Delhi. The list of participants is placed at Annexure 'A'.

At the outset, the Secretary (Environment) welcomed all participants and requested the DIAL representative to set the context and give the presentation on the agenda of the meeting. DIAL Wildlife In-Charge gave the detailed presentation wherein the action points for the concerned areas were discussed as follows:

1) Illegal waste dumping & De-skinning of Animals at Rangpuri Pahadi

Officers from DIAL informed that DDA has constructed the wall around the concern area, which has significantly reduced the activity of garbage dumping in this area. However sewage drain water of un-authorized colony Mahipal Pur K Block is diverted to this area which contributes to significant bird movements, which is observed during each survey visit.

Secretary (Environment) had directed that till the proper sewerage is provided in the colony, land owning agency (DDA) to ensure the water is collected from the site and sent to sewerage treatment plant on regular basis.

(Action: DDA, Delhi Police)

2) Illegal Meat Selling in Indra Market – R. K. Puram and irregular removal of garbage /slaughter waste from drain/area by SDMC.

Officers from DIAL informed that wall is constructed on only front side of market and adjacent drain. In previous AEMC meeting DDA was directed to consider erection of



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boundary wall using wire mesh around entire market to safe guard their land and avoid re-encroachment by illegal meat seller. SDMC was also directed to provide garbage bin and increase frequency of garbage collection.

Secretary (Environment) instructed that,

- I. Regular inspection /enforcement to be conducted at every 15 days by South MCD veterinary wing. Delhi Police to be requested to keep watch on illegal activity/encroachment in the above said area. DDA was asked to complete the construction of boundary wall to barricade the entire area.
- II. SDMC was advised to look into re-modification of existing Dhalao structure, so that it becomes accessible to user. It was also suggested by the Secretary (Environment) that a Pilot project for underground Dhalao be explored by DIAL under CSR.

(Action: SDMC, DDA, Delhi Police, DIAL)

3) Garbage Dump at Shahabad Mohammad Pur Village and at various places in Bagdola village which is located on Runway 10 approach path.

Official from DIAL informed that expected level of garbage clearing is not observed in the area. Secretary (Environment) directed SDMC to increase the frequency of garbage removal for proper disposal of garbage and to conduct awareness program for educating people of nearby areas about risk involvement in aviation due to open dumping of waste/garbage. Executive Engineer, SDMC to carry out inspection at least once in 15 days. It was also agreed that dhalao will constructed in the area. SDMC and DIAL to jointly identify area for the same.

(Action: SDMC, DIAL)

4) There is urgent need of constructing of 2-3 dhalao in Bharthal village for garbage accumulated on daily basis. One of the garbage dump is on Indian Railways land.

It was informed by EE, SDMC that tendering process for the construction of two new Dhalao has been initiated and same is under process. The Dhalaos will be constructed shortly.

(Action: DDA/SDMC)



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5) Garbage Disposal around Dwarka Area and Railway Track

It was informed by official from DIAL that waste is seeing dumped on railway land on both sides of railway line which lies in approach path of all 3 runways i.e 09/10 & 11. Secretary (Environment) directed SDMC to left the garbage from railway land in Delhi. Secretary (Environment) further clarified that irrespective of ownership of land the garbage/waste material has to be cleared by Municipal Corporation as per instructions of Honorable Lieutenant Governor Delhi.

(Action: SDMC, Indian Railways)

6) Garbage dumping in open near Manglapuri Bus Terminal and illegal meat shops in Manglapuri.

It was informed by DIAL that there has been considerable improvement in the area regarding garbage removal by SDMC. However, the frequency of cleaning needs to be increased. Secretary (Environment) directed SDMC to increase frequency of waste removal and not to keep waste dump in open area.

(Action: SDMC)

7) Dwarka Sector 8 drain and adjacent area

It was informed by official from DIAL that service road adjacent to Dwarka Sector 8 drain needs to be maintained otherwise there is high possibility of garbage accumulation in this area as it also add to dust pollution. Necessary greening of the area was advised.

Secretary (Environment) directed DDA to repair the service road and SDMC was instructed to clear the garbage/construction material from the site.

(Action: SDMC, DDA)

New Points:

- 1) **PochanPur**: It was informed that at Pochan Pur area huge amount of garbage has been accumulated with no proper garbage disposal system. SDMC was advised to ensure the cleanliness of the area.

(Action: SDMC)



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- 2) Jai Hind Colony: It was informed that Jai Hind colony area needs immediate attention as there is huge amount of garbage has been accumulated in the area with no proper garbage disposal system. DDA official informed that the cleaning of the area has been carried out and a security guard has been posted to ensure there is no further littering. It was agreed that DDA officials along with DIAL would carry out joint inspection of the said area.

(Action: DDA, DIAL)

At the end, Secretary (Environment) concluded by appreciating the efforts of all agencies and asked them to continue working to improve the situation.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
